- The purpose of this project is to implement a workforce time management solution which interfaces with Oracle PeopleSoft system (UT Share HR system).
- Currently various processes are being followed throughout the campus to track employee time: TimePro clocks, Excel, SharePoint, paper forms. The new application will standardize and enhance employee time keeping and absence management processes for the entire organization.
- TimeClock Plus was selected through an RFP bid process by the Timekeeping Evaluation team.
- TimeClock Plus is a workforce management solution for time collection, absence/PTO management, and workforce scheduling, all in one application. The new system will be implemented to facilitate consistency in reporting hours worked and hours absent for various employee types (Faculty, Administrative and Professional, Classified Exempt, and Classified Non-exempt).
- The application will deliver accurate and timely notifications for both supervisors (or designated proxies) and payroll departments in order to streamline the time and labor functions. TimeClock Plus will have a two-way integration with the main system of records Oracle PeopleSoft (UT Share).

TimeClock Plus will offer employee self-service to:

- Simplify time entry (report and view hours worked in one application)
- View schedules (if applicable)
- Increase accuracy and timeliness of hours worked reporting
- Increase visibility for viewing leave balances (leave hours available/taken)
- Simplify the process of requesting time off

TimeClock Plus will offer managers the ability to:

- Create a single time-keeping process across campus
- Eliminate the differences in programs and processing
- Decrease the number of personnel necessary for support
- Decrease training time
